ORDER

Counsel has submitted a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and a motion to be relieved as counsel. We deny the motion to be relieved as counsel and direct the parties to brief the following issues:

1. Did the trial court err in finding the cracked condition of the windshield in this case constituted a traffic violation under section 56-5-5310 of the South Carolina Code (1976), so that there was probable cause to initiate the traffic stop?
