On October 17-18, 2011, the above case was tried before the Honorable Judge Cothran in Clarendon County General Sessions Court. I was not retained to represent Mr. Felder on his appeal, so I filed a notice of appeal and sent him all of the paperwork necessary to get appointed counsel.
