

ORDER


By order dated September 20, 2012, we dismissed appellant's notice of appeal in this matter. Appellant has now filed a motion to reconsider and an amended motion to reconsider in which he also seeks permission to file a motion to arrest his sentence of life without parole imposed for a 1998 burglary conviction in the circuit court. Both motions to reconsider are denied, including appellant's request in his initial motion to reconsider that this Court remand the motion to arrest sentence to the circuit court or assume jurisdiction over the motion and appoint a special referee. We also deny appellant's request for permission to file the motion to arrest sentence in the circuit court.






