Buddy Nicholson, Jr. In support of this petition, counsel submits the following information.

(1) The sentencing portion of the trial transcript was not included in the original transcript from the court reporter. On page 275 of the transcript, the court reporter indicates: "There were no more audio files to be transcribed. Therefore, sentencing portion of the trial, to be heard 082609, is not included."






