ORDER

Appellate Defender Susan B. Hackett, of the Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense, requests the Court appoint counsel outside the Division of Appellate Defense to represent petitioner due to a conflict of interest. Ms. Hackett also requests the timelines for filing the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix be held in abeyance pending consideration of the motion. The State opposes the motion to appoint outside counsel.

The motion to appoint counsel outside counsel is denied. Deputy Chief Appellate Defender Wanda H. Carter shall assign herself or another attorney in the Division of Appellate Defense to represent petitioner and the assigned attorney shall have no communications with Ms. Hackett or Chief Appellate Defender Robert M. Dudek regarding the case.

We grant the request to hold the timeline for filing the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix in abeyance pending this decision on the motion for the appointment of outside counsel.
