Dear Solicitor Thurmond:

Please be advised that the Remittitur in the appeal of Mr. Miller's Aiken County convictions and sentences was issued on May 18, 2016 after denial of the State's Petition for Rehearing filed April 14, 2016. The decision in State v. Antonio Miller, Memorandum Opinion No. 2016-MO-0009 (2016) reversed Mr. Miller's convictions and remanded his indictments to the Court of General Sessions for a new trial. This Office is currently considering whether to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the United States Supreme Court.

As a result of the issuance of the Remittitur, by copy of this letter, with a separate e-mail of last Friday, May 20, 2016, we are requesting the Department of Corrections, through the Legal Advisor's Office and your office to coordinate the expeditious transfer of Mr. Miller to the custody of Aiken County for treatment as a pretrial detainee on each of the indictments involved in the Remittitur. By copy of his letter, I am advising his current counsel, Robert M. Dudek, of this communication.
