
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

This letter is to follow up with my call with the case manager on May 19, 2016, regarding the two above related appeals. As discussed, the Court inadvertently sent a letter indicating that our initial briefing deadline was missed and that our initial briefs were due on May 26, 2016. As noted by the case manager, the letter was triggered by our receipt of the transcripts and our informing the Court of same. The Court on February 3, 2016, however, had previously held all deadlines in abeyance in order to consider whether the issue on appeal was one of the variety that is immediately appealable. From my discussion with the case manager, it is my understanding that the Court has determined that the mode of trial issue is immediately appealable, the stay is lifted, and that briefing will be due thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of a subsequent letter from the Court setting the deadline. I was instructed not to file my initial briefs on May 26, 2016, but to await the later letters from the Court. Since I have not received the new letters from the Court setting the proper 30-day deadlines, I am writing the Court this letter to memorialize for the case files and the Clerk that I have been told not to file our initial
