
Defendant requests the Court's rationale for its decision in granting Plaintiff's Motion to Compel, with the qualification that the material sought be under protective order in that said material will be presented to the trial judge under seal for further determination of admissibility by the trial court. That rationale is based upon review of the testimony presented to the Court, the documents presented to the Court, as well as review of S.C. Code Ann. § 63-7-1990, which allows for further review by the trial judge in camera to determine the "relevancy and necessity of the disclosure," and also to limit that disclosure to "legally relevant information under a protective order." S.C. Code Ann. § 63-7-1990(B)(11).

THEREFORE, Defendant's Motion to Reconsider is DENIED.
