Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I hereby submit this letter, with proof of service, in accordance with the provisions of Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR.

I bring to the attention of the Court and other counsel the provisions of Rule 2, subsection (3) of Rule 416.

I also bring to the attention of the Court and to the attention of other counsel in this case the South Carolina Supreme Court's decision in Richardson, Plowdeen, Grier and Howser v Pyle, 472 S.E.2d 232, 322 S.C. 371 (SC, 1996).

Inasmuch as Rule 208(b)(7) requires me to state the reasons for the supplemental citations, I draw attention to the proposition that these authorities provide that the Resolution of Fee Dispute Board has no jurisdiction over fee disputes over which a court has acquired jurisdiction. In the case at hand, the Lower Court had not only acquired jurisdiction of any fee dispute, it had already issued its order requiring payment of the fees due in a specified amount from a specific fund prior to any suggestion or argument by the Appellant to the Lower Court that it should allow the Resolution of Fee Disputes Board to adjudicate this Respondent's entitlement to the balance of his fees.

As required by Rule 208(b)(7), I bring to the attention of the Court and other counsel the fact that these citations are relevant to the argument made in this respondent's initial brief on page 16 (argument number 3).


