Dear Mr. Temple:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency has been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- Pursuant to Rule 203, SCACR, the notice of appeal has not been timely filed with this Court. A motion to allow the late filing will have to be made.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. It must name the attorney of record being served, not only the firm.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 203, SCACR. Specifically, it must contain the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.
