Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your client's correspondence dated February 1, 2016, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. The proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The proof of service must show that the notice of appeal was timely served on the respondent (The State).
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, all parties must be listed.
