ORDER

After careful consideration, we find the circuit court's interlocutory order is not immediately appealable. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 14-3-330 (1) & (2) (1976) (stating that to be appealable an interlocutory order must (1) involve the merits of the case or (2) affect a substantial right when the order in effect determines the action and prevents a judgment from which an appeal might be taken); *see also Weldon v. Southern Ry. Co.*, 167 S.C. 526, 166 S.E. 723 (1932) (finding an order requiring the plaintiff to make allegations in the complaint more definite and certain is not immediately appealable). Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
