COMES NOW the Petitioner, Charleston Country School District, by and through its undersigned counsel, and the Respondent, Ricky Rhame, and hereby respectfully requests that this Honorable Court grant a stay in this matter pending the parties finalizing settlement of this case.

The Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, on February 23, 2016, seeking a review of the Court of Appeals' decision of December 9, 2015. The Respondent timely filed a return, and the Petitioner timely filed a reply. 

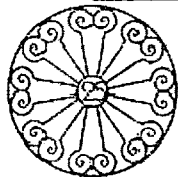
Blake,
