and Mrs. Becker, Marjorie, Soper, E.C.T., Show Cause, in by answer to this
petition which is herewith served upon you pursuant to Rule 45 C.R.C. within
20 days exclusive of the day of service or as the Court may direct. If you
fail to do so, Judgment by default will be taken against you. Relief requested

① preliminary injunction should not issue pursuant to Rule 65 C.R.C. in enjoining
the defendants, their successor in office, agents and employees and all other persons acting in
concert and participation with them from, opening, taking or concealing and delaying the
delivery of all legal mail addressed to petitioner or petitioner's associates and family and
in the past. It is further Ordered that effective immediately and pending the hearing
and determination of this order to show cause, the defendants, Wanda, Willie, Evelyn, E.C.T. and
Mrs. Becker, Marjorie, Soper, against whom the petition is against and each of them, their
agents, employees and all other persons acting in concert or participation with them are
restrained from concealing, stealing, hiding, taking of any cell legal mail addressed
to petitioner.
