


Dear Mr. Wilkes:

I have received your letter requesting a transcript of a hearing before The Honorable Perry H. Gravely on October 20th, 2015, in the above-referenced action.

A review of the record indicates that a deposit in the amount of \$207.25 is required to accept your request. Transcript requests are not accepted without the required deposit. This is an estimated amount. If the cost of the transcript is more than the required amount, you will be notified to remit the balance. If the cost is less than the deposit, a refund will accompany the transcript on delivery. Once a valid deposit is received, the transcript will be provided within sixty days from the date of receipt, unless an extension for cause is granted.
