I am writing on behalf of the Appellant, Founders Federal Credit Union ("Founders"), regarding our understanding as to the remainder of the briefing deadlines under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules ("SCACR") in this case. On May 23, 2016, the Court sent me a letter asking that we file Founders' final brief and record on appeal within twenty days because the Respondents had not yet filed their initial brief. However, we received The Auto Shop's initial brief on June 6, 2016. Now that the The Auto Shop has filed its initial brief, it is our understanding that the remainder of the briefing deadlines will revert to those stated in Rules 207 through 211 of the SCACR.
