

Appellant hereby moves pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for a 30-day extension of the time in which to serve and file Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal in this case. The grounds for this motion are that there is good cause to grant the requested extension, as the following shows:

1. The deadline for service and filing of Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal is currently June 24, 2016.
2. This is the first extension that the undersigned has sought in this appeal.
3. Appellant's counsel seek a 30-day extension of this deadline in order to give them time to complete the brief.




