The State moved to dismiss Groves's appeal, arguing the circuit court's order denying Groves's motion to dismiss is not immediately appealable. We grant the motion. *See State v. Isaac*, 405 S.C. 177, 183, 747 S.E.2d 680, 681 (2013) ("[G]enerally, a criminal defendant may not appeal until sentence is imposed."). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
