Dear Ms. Allen:

I am writing as counsel to the Respondent, Beaufort County School District, in the above matter. We are very concerned regarding the propriety of the motions recently filed by Appellant, John Alden Bauer, III. We are particularly concerned in light of the fact that Mr. Bauer, who we recognize is proceeding *pro se*, has yet to indicate that he has ordered the transcript of the proceedings below. The text of Rule 207, SCACR, is clear that Mr. Bauer was required to order the transcript within 10 days after the date of service of the notice of appeal, which in this case was May 2, 2016. You reminded Mr. Bauer of the requirement of Rule 207 in your June 9, 2016 letter. If Mr. Bauer has not provided the required notice by June, 22, 2016, we intend to seek dismissal of his appeal under Rule 260, SCACR.

Given the current posture of this appeal, the Respondent does not believe it is required, nor would it be appropriate at this time, to file any opposition to Mr. Bauer's motions, which clearly are premature and improper. We do, however, reserve our right to file any opposition to those motions, particularly the Motion of the Appellant to Consider Relevant Evidence, at the appropriate time, if and when Mr. Bauer takes the proper steps under the rules and as stated in your June 9 correspondence to him. We also reserve the right to challenge Mr. Bauer's motions as being frivolous pursuant to Rule 269, SCACR, and to seek attorney's fees in connection therewith.


If our understanding of the current status of this appeal and the pending matters is mistaken, or if there are specific actions or steps that Respondent should take at this time, please so advise.



Greetings. Yes, sir, I actually sent the (huge, 587-page) original transcript up on Friday, but then rushed out of town to Charleston to avoid a storm so I could help a friend move over the weekend, and have been hanging around my old West Ashley stomping grounds since. (Random aside, I discovered, with enough rope, it's possible to move a loveseat on top of my Jeep. Yay, Boy Scout knot techniques!)

However, apologies on the delay in responding to email. I only this afternoon got my work laptop up here with me.

So I am able to send out a PDF file of the hearing itself and could probably email the complainant's exhibits. However, y'all's exhibit file wound up being larger, because it's a color scan instead of the usual black and white, and most email addresses would bounce it, at 23 megabytes. I could burn it to a DVD and send it, if you'd like.

Then I won't really be able to invoice y'all until I get back to Beaufort, which I'm thinking will be Friday, but it depends on whether I can get in touch of the current owners of my old dog. (Long story -- again, feel free to skip -- but I had to give him up after fire here last year and moving back to Beaufort. Rescue dog, but he looked too close to one of the restricted breeds for my landlord's carrier's tastes. Ever since my brother went out to see him a couple moths back, I've been dying to see for myself how he's doing. Such a good puppy.)

Anyhow, as an aside, while this is only my third project of this sort, I'll tell you this would be the first time a respondent has gotten a hearing transcript directly from me. I also know at least one of the other two got appealed. So you may want to find out from someone in the know whether y'all would wind up with a copy of the transcript through the discovery process somehow. I mean, believe me, I'm happy to send and invoice it. Just let me know. But I thought I'd throw that out there, just in case it'd save you -- what, about a grand? (That's why I can't make invoice until I get back to Beaufort. I can't remember the new rate on a paperless copy, off the top of my head.) 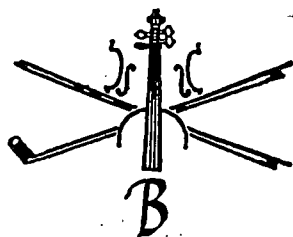
Alden is headed to the Court of Appeals.
