

ORDER

This appeal arises out of the denial of the appellants' motion to set aside entry of default pursuant to Rule 55(c) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure. A grant or denial of a motion to set aside entry of default is not directly appealable. *See Jefferson by Johnson v. Gene's Used Cars, Inc.*, 295 S.C. 317, 317, 368 S.E.2d 456, 456 (1988). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. Remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
