ORDER

By order dated June 1, 2016, this Court determined, among other things, that the South Carolina Court of Appeals had properly sent the remittitur in this case. Petitioner has now filed a motion asking this Court to compel the Court of Appeals to take further action in the case, or for this Court to assume jurisdiction over this case. Since the remittitur has been properly sent, appellate jurisdiction has ended,¹ and neither this Court nor the Court of Appeals can take any further action regarding this case. Accordingly, the motion is denied.
