
1. The Appellants have filed their Motion to dismiss the Appellants Pat Huckabee and The Huckabee, LLC from this consolidated Appeal.





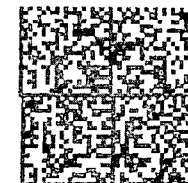
