This responds to your motion to exceed the page, petition for writ of certiorari and appendix. Since you are represented by counsel in this matter,<sup>1</sup> no action will be taken on these *pro se* filings. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989).

Instead, if it is appropriate seek review of the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in *State v. McBride*, Appellate Case Number 2013-002391, the petition for a writ of certiorari will have to be filed by your counsel.

To give your counsel an opportunity to serve and file a petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix under Rule 242, SCACR, or to move to be relieved as your counsel if that is appropriate, I am asking the Court of Appeals not to send the
