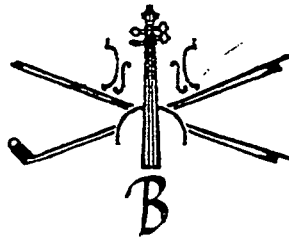


Thank you for yours of June 21, 2016.
