## ORDER

The motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Appellant is permitted to file only one copy of the initial brief, record on appeal, and final brief with this court. Appellant, however, is still required to serve Respondent with the copies of all filings, including the record on appeal and briefs, as well as all mailings to this court. The covers may be of any material and in any color, and must contain only the caption. *See* Rules 208, 210, 211, 240, SCACR.
