

ORDER

Raymond Young filed a motion to consolidate his appeal, *State v. Raymond Young*, Case No. 2013-000149, with this appeal. Young later clarified he wished to consolidate the records on appeal as he and Appellant were co-defendants and both appeals present similar issues on similar facts. The State consented to the motion and requested any pending time frames for submission of initial briefs, the consolidated record on appeal, and final briefs in both cases be controlled by the filing deadlines in Young's appeal. Appellant consented via letter to Young's motion and the State's request as to the filing deadlines. Accordingly, we grant Young's request to consolidate the records on appeal and the State's request to have the filing deadlines for both appeals be controlled by Young's appeal. The consolidated records on appeal shall be served within thirty days after service of the last initial brief. *See* Rule 210(a), SCACR.
