

## ORDER

---

Respondent has filed a "motion to strike and compel filing of complete record on appeal." We note Appellant has filed a corrected record on appeal containing all items in both Appellant's and Respondent's designations of matter. However, while Appellant has included the August 12, 2014 order, the index to the record on appeal does not include that order. Furthermore, the corrected record is not consecutively paginated as required by the appellate court rules. *See* Rule 210, SCACR (requiring "[e]ach page of the Record on appeal shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the index"). Accordingly, Respondent's motion to strike is granted.

Appellant has also notified this court he is unable to send the required copies of the record on appeal because he is indigent. We construe Appellant's letter as a request to reduce the number of copies of the record on appeal required to be filed with this court. We grant Appellant's request. Within thirty days of this order, Appellant shall serve a copy of the amended record on appeal on Respondent and file seven copies of the amended record on appeal with this court.<sup>1</sup>
