At a Court of General Sessions, convened on MARCH 12, 2015 the Grand Jurors of FLORENCE County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE- FAILURE TO STOP FOR A BLUE LIGHT RESULTING IN DEATH

That KYEON TRESEAN GLOVER did in Florence County on or about October 29, 2014, while operating a motor vehicle on a road, street, or highway of the State of South Carolina, fail to stop his/her motor vehicle when signaled to do so by a law enforcement vehicle, by means of a siren and/or flashing light, and that the death of VINCENT THOMAS resulted when the defendant performed an act forbidden by law or neglected a duty imposed by law in the driving of the vehicle, in violation of Section 56-05-0750(C)(2), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO- BURGLARY FIRST DEGREE

That KYEON TRESEAN GLOVER did in Florence County on or about October 29, 2014 enter the dwelling of JACQUETTA POMPEY located at 905 June Lane, Apartment B, Florence, South Carolina without consent and with the intent to commit a crime therein and when, in effecting entry or while in the dwelling or in immediate flight, the defendant entered in the nighttime, while armed with a deadly weapon, to wit: a handgun, in violation of Section 16-11-0311, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended.

COUNT THREE - ASSAULT AND BATTERY FIRST DEGREE

That KYEON TRESEAN GLOVER did in Florence County on or about October 29, 2014 commit, an unlawful act of injury with the present ability to do so to JACQUETTA POMPEY and the act occurred during the commission of a burglary, to wit: by punching her in the head repeatedly and striking her in the head with a beer bottle, in violation of Section 16-3-600(C)(1), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT FOUR- ASSAULT AND BATTERY SECOND DEGREE

That KYEON TRESEAN GLOVER did in Florence County on or about October 29, 2014 commit, an unlawful act of injury with the present ability to do so to A JUVENILE and the act caused moderate bodily injury to the victim, to wit: by hitting her with his fists, in violation of Section 16-3-600(D)(1), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT FIVE- POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING A VIOLENT CRIME

That KYEON TRESEAN GLOVER did in Florence County, on or about October 29, 2014, possess a firearm, during the commission of a violent crime, in violation of Section 16-23-0490, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
