Appellant, Ronnie Joe Vanzant, upon his oath and subject to penalty of perjury, hereby deposes and states the following:

1. I am over the age of eighteen and otherwise competent to execute this Affidavit. I have personal knowledge of the matters set forth herein.
2. I am the Plaintiff in this action
3. In pertinent part, I filed a Notice of Intent to file suit for medical mal-practice against the Defendants/Respondents on or about Jan. 11th 2016.
4. Contemporaneously, I also file a motion to waive expert witness pursuant to the Common Knowledge Doctrine. All this was done pursuant and in accordance with South Carolina Statute § 15-79-125(A), and § 15-36-100 (C)(2).
5. Subsequently, on March 30th, 2016, in front of Honorable J.C. Nicholson, Jr. My motion to proceed without a medical expert witness was denied and I was given 45-days to obtain said expert witness.

6. Since this short Order / indicates that a more full and complete Judgment is to follow after the ordered (45)-days, Plaintiff waited for the final Judgment that ultimately took place on 6/30/2016.
7. In addition, the written notice of entry to the order of Judge Nicholson on March 30th, 2016 did not come timely
8. The Charleston County Detention Center does have a bad habit of conveniently miss-placing mail. There has been times that I have received mail over (30)-days past the postage date on envelope.
9. To be safe, on May 26th 2016 I wrote the clerks office requesting a copy of this said written notice of entry order from the March 30th, 2016 court date in front of Judge Nicholson. See Exhibit "A".
9. I ended up receiving this said written notice of entry order on or about June 18th, 2016. Notice the postage date on the envelope of Exhibit "B". - (June 16th 2016).
10. Ultimately, the full complete order and Judgment for appeal purposes was final on June 3rd 2016 in front of Judge Russo. The case was Dismissed Without Prejudice for not obtaining a expert medical witness Affidavit, ^{pursuant to motion.} ~~and~~ (2)
