

Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Christopher A. Baty v. The State on May 23, 2016 with the Supreme Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Clark D. Thomas v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 18, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jamal Hakeem on May 11, 2016 with this Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Sammy Lee Scarborough on May 4, 2016 with the Supreme Court. 
4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


