MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR FILING APPELLANT'S BRIEFS

I, Ann Stevenson, hereby request a Time Extension until September 21, 2016 to file appellant's briefs in the above-captioned appeal for the following reasons:

- 1) I am currently being treated for Facial Shingles involving the nerves on the right side of my face, nose, eye, ear, mouth, and head creating and causing many unmanageable symptoms which are disabling me from functioning and driving and in the heat and light.
- 2) I am waiting to be seen by an ophthalmologist and other doctors for the complications of the shingles.
- 3) Before contracting The Shingles and before my lawyer, Carter Martling, was removed from my case, everyone I contacted – lawyers and others -- about my case refused to give me any information, refused to discuss anything with me, including the ombudsman evidently because my lawyer had not released me. I was refused access to my case files and all information. What I had believed happened had not from glancing at the transcript of the 2015 hearing which was not acquired before the 2016 hearing. The transcript was required to file the appeal and the fee was paid to Mr Martling. and received in April 2016 with a copy of the original receipt. The only one who helped told me about the website and forms pleasantly was Monica there so I was able to file my appeal.

- 4) Once, I am over as much of the Shingles symptoms as possible I would like to be able to make an appointment with Amy Bracey to see my case file in Columbia and look at my file from my former lawyer which was recently sent to me after a refusal for access when I was in Columbia in the spring.

- 5) Also I have prior injuries from this appeal that cause problems walking, driving, and moving distances which slow and prevent me from some physical activities to where I have needed help from my sister or mother or others.
