Dear Honorable SIR:

I received your correspondence stating that I have to pay \$138.75 in which I do not have nor my family to receive copies of my 483 pages of documents. I know it's not the fault of the courts but negligence on the part of South Carolina Department of Corrections who violated a protected right of mine by denying me my legal material in time so that I could get copies of my legal documents. South Carolina Department of Corrections violated their own policy/procedures GA-01.03 Inmate Access to the courts state/federal statutes and case law. Bounds v Smith, 97 S. Ct. 1491 (1977), Lewis v Casey 116 S. Ct. 2174 (1996)

Policy statement in order to provide inmates with adequate access to the courts, SCDC will establish and maintain an institutional Law Library system to afford inmates access to

to legal materials in compliance with the requirements of related case law.

Maximum security unit (SMU or RHU) inmate access. To ensure equal access to the courts.

13.1 Inmates may request photocopies of legal materials and documents to support a pleading.

13.5 The inmate's E.H. Cooper Trust Fund will be debited in order to pay for photocopies, with the exception of copies of documents originated by the inmate (see procedure 13.2 above) and specific cases and Agency policies and procedures available for review in the Library (see procedure 13.3).

Indigent inmates will be permitted to make photocopies, however, their accounts will be debited to ensure reimbursement to the Agency once funds become available in their account. The office of General Counsel makes these policy which is connected to the Attorney General office which is connected to the state of South Carolina. I am a prisoner and without assistance of Administration I can't file necessary paperwork with out them assisting me. It was CDC responsibility to get my legal boxes to me. I am in segregation and I wrote all the responsible authorities telling them I had pending cases for months then when I got the proper material I only had a certain amount of time to have it in the courts.

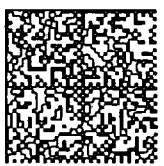
It was negligence on the part of SCDC
