This matter came before the Court on November 19, 2015 as a non-jury trial. Based on the evidence and testimony presented at trial, the Court hereby finds in favor of the Plaintiff as to her claims of conversion of funds, fraud, misrepresentation, and violation of the Unfair Trade Practices Act against the Defendant. The Court further finds that the Plaintiff is entitled to requested damages of \$447.37 for conversion of funds, \$1,575.25 for uncompleted work, and \$1,500 for a replacement transmission. In addition, the Court finds a violation of the Unfair Trade Practices Act in this case to be willful and thus the violation warrants treble damages. Therefore, Plaintiff is entitled to a total of \$10,567.86 in damages.
