## ORDER

Respondent filed a motion to compel Appellant to correct the record on appeal by replacing Defendant's Exhibit 25 with the correct exhibit submitted into evidence at trial. Appellant's response acknowledged the error and stated Appellant would file a supplement to the record and appendix. Respondent replied to Appellant's response by moving to have Appellant physically remove the incorrect exhibit from the record on appeal and number the correct exhibit in the supplemental record with the same page numbers used for the incorrect exhibit. After careful consideration, Appellant is directed to file the supplemental record on appeal. As the disputed exhibit is a judicial opinion issued by this court, removal from the record is not necessary as it could be properly considered by this court.
