- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption is not listed correctly. The caption should read as follows:

v.

Walmart Stores East, Respondent.

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The appellant's initial brief does not contain the Table of Contents and Cases, Statement of Issues on Appeal, Statement of the Case, Argument, and Conclusion. The appellant's initial brief must contain the content listed pursuant to Rule 208(b)(1)(A), (B), (C), (D), and (E).
