Dear Mr. and Mrs. Cain:

Upon reviewing your appellants' initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal may be dismissed:

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. You must serve and file a designation of matter that is in compliance with Rule 209 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
- Your brief is single spaced and is not signed by both of the appellants. You must serve and file an amended appellants' initial brief that does not include your designated material, is double spaced, is signed by both appellants, and in all other ways is in compliance with Rule 208, SCACR.
- The Court will consider respondent's motion to dismiss after the ten days have passed to allow appellants to correct these deficiencies.

- Appellants' filing received in the Clerk's office June 9, 2016, is not in compliance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. This filing is being returned to the appellants.
