
Upon reviewing your "Motion for Default," which this Court construes as a Notice of Appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the Workers' Compensation Commission has not been provided as required by Rule 203(e), SCACR.
- The proof of service accompanying the notice of appeal is deficient. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must

provide the names of the parties that have been served, as well as an address for each party.

- The notice of appeal is deficient. You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- We are returning the documents included with your filings, as it is not necessary to provide the material at this time. Please see Rule 210, SCACR, for guidance on when to file the record on appeal with the Court.
