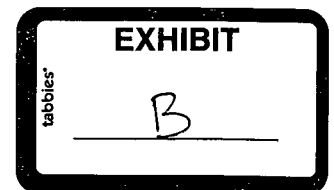

This matter came before the Court on November, 6, 2014, with the Plaintiff requesting money damages on her claims associated with the property damages resulting from a traffic accident involving the Defendants. This matter was referred to my office for a damages hearing pursuant to Rule 55 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure.

Judge Paul Burch adjudged the Defendants to be in default and ordered a damages hearing. The Plaintiff, her father, and Counsel for the Plaintiff were present at this damages hearing. Counsel for the Defendants appeared as well. Evidence was offered as to the amount and nature of the Plaintiff's damages. The Plaintiff and her father, Mr. Antonio Hough, testified and made reference to documents evidencing a total loss of the automobile in question, along with out of pocket expenses incurred and general damages. The value of the use of this automobile, of which the plaintiff has been deprived, as well as expenses of obtaining substitute transportation, together with the replacement costs warrant a reasonable sum to compensate the Plaintiff for the actual loss and loss of use of her automobile.

After reflection upon this matter, the Court finds that the Plaintiff has shown damages proximately caused by the defaulting Defendants in the amount of \$25,000.00.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that the Court awards judgment, both jointly and severally, in the amount of \$25,000.00 against the defaulting Defendants, Cardinal Logistics Management Corporation and Ronnie Lee Clark.


