MOTION TO ORDER TRANSCRIPT OUT OF TIME

The Appellant, Retha Pierce Sturdivant, for Appellate Case No.: 2016-000504 submits to the Honorable Court the Motion to Order Transcript Out of Time. The move is due to subsequent reasons:

1. Multiple bouts of incapacitation due to Appellant's permanent disability since 1994 (22 years), which ensued and ran concurrently to the dictates of four overlapping wrongful cases (2 state, 2 federal). This, through no fault of her own, made it impossible for the Appellant to meet any obligation on time during that phase as a result of spontaneous debilitations **which** resulted contingently with levels of stress as diagnosed following several years of treatment by medical/special doctors as a result of an injury to her spine which was equated with a gun shot/knife stab that usually leaves its victim permanently paralyzed. For several consecutive weeks, the Appellant experienced recurring periods of immobility and nonfunctioning that affected her ability to complete even meager tasks.

2. Excruciating pains and nonworking of key body ligaments did much to impede progress.

3. Usual attempts to work in spite of the aforementioned odds, by putting mind over matter, were additionally interrupted by repeated computer crashes.

4. Overwhelmed by overlapping deadlines for remaining wrongful cases (2 federal, 2 state) as a result of at least twelve(12) wrongful charges for which the Appellant was falsely jailed at least eight(8) times during nearly a ten-year span --- all interlocked and bound by an intricately woven web of deception and concerted cover ups.


5. The above-mentioned factors have contributed to Appellate's Motion to Order Transcript Out of Time for Appellate Case No.: 2016- 000504 through no fault of her own.

6. That the undersigned Appellant is convinced that her appeal has substantial merit, that

there would be no prejudice in the granting of this motion, and believes that the matter set forth above constitutes good cause for the setting of said motion.

7. Appellant respectfully requests that all matters pertaining to this appeal for Appellate Case No.: 2016-000504 be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion. Wherefore, Appellant prays that this Honorable Court inquire into the matters set forth herein and issue its order granting the Motion to Order Transcript Out of Time for Appellate Case No.: 2016-000504 and hold all time limits in abeyance pending a ruling in this motion.
