ORDER

Respondents moved for an extension of time to file their initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal because of Respondents' counsel's health condition. Respondents subsequently notified this court that their attorney is now deceased. We grant Respondents' motion for an extension of time. Respondents have thirty days from the date of this order to retain new counsel. If Respondents do not notify this court of their within thirty days of the date of this order, Respondents will be presumed to be proceeding pro se. Respondents have sixty days from the date of this order to file their initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

Appellant's counsel has filed a motion to substitute parties, explaining Appellant is now deceased and requesting Emily Nichols Felder, Executor of the Estate of Mamie F. Nichols, to be substituted in her place. The motion to substitute is granted pursuant to Rule 265(b), SCACR, and the caption is amended as set forth in this order.

Appellant's counsel, Ayesha T. Washington, has filed a motion to be relieved as counsel. The motion is granted. Appellant's remaining counsel, Precious Felder, has been admitted pro hac vice for this case. Appellant must retain a member of South Carolina Bar to be associated as attorney of record within thirty days of the

date of this order.
