ORDER

Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief was denied by the Honorable Deadra Jefferson. No notice of appeal was filed. Petitioner now seeks a writ of certiorari from an order issued by the Honorable J.C. Nicholson finding petitioner is entitled to a belated review of Judge Jefferson's order pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991).

Based on the vote of the Court, the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Nicholson's order is granted. The Court has dispensed with further briefing and proceeded with an *Austin* review of Judge Jefferson's order.
