Janet,
I just spoke to Jessica Kinard who handled that hearing. This case is still under advisement. When the judge makes his decision, he will let counsel know. If the decision is to deny, he will ask Jessica to draft an order denying PCR. She will draft a proposed order and send it to the judge. At that time Mr. Fowler will also receive a copy of the proposed order. When the judge signs the order he will either send it to us to file with the clerk or send it directly to the clerk who should file it and serve the order on all counsel. I'm guessing that the box checked in the middle was the best choice for the person who filled it out, and was not intended to end the case. When I look at Court Records on the Judicial website. It's pretty clear the Georgetown Clerk of Court still shows the case as under advisement.

We did receive the notice of appeal, but I don't think there was a proof of service on it.
