ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from the Administrative Law Court's order dismissing Appellant's appeal because Appellant was granted a rehearing of his disciplinary conviction. Because Appellant was granted a rehearing, Appellant is not an aggrieved party and there is no final order for this court to review at this time. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610(A)(1) (Supp. 2012) (providing that judicial review may only be sought by an aggrieved party from a final decision of the ALC). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
