At a Court of General Sessions, convened on **SEP 16 2014** the Grand Jurors of Greenville
County present upon their oath:

COUNT I - MURDER

That JACOBY JAMAR GREGORY did in Greenville County, on or about the 1st day of October, 2013,
unlawfully and with malice aforethought kill BARRY NORMAN by means of shooting him, and that BARRY
NORMAN died as a proximate result thereof. This is in violation of §16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of
Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT II - POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME
