Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR. Your signature must be on the conclusion page of your brief.
- The "certificate of compliance" that you have provided with your brief is improper and is being returned to you.
- Your argument included in your brief is single spaced. You must serve and file an amended initial brief that is double-spaced and is in all other ways compliant with Rule 208, SCACR.
- The caption on the cover of your initial brief is inconsistent with the example of the caption provided to you in the Court's correspondence. A copy of the Court's letter is attached for your reference.
