MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Isaac Romell Williams respectfully requests a fourth extension of thirty (30) days, **until August 19, 2016**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kelvin Bowen v. The State of South Carolina on June 23, 2016 with the Supreme Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Quentin Jenkins v. The State of South Carolina on June 14, 2016 with the Supreme Court. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Maurice Odom on June 10, 2016 with this Court. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Michael D. Brooks on June 1, 2016 with this Court. 
4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload
