

ORDER GRANTING
DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO

This matter comes before the Court on Defendants' Motion to Dismiss this case filed on about May 10, 2016. The Defendant cites to a May 9, 2016 hearing before this Court on Defendant's Motion to Compel discovery from the Plaintiff.
