

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Lywone Capers in the Supreme Court on May 18, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Damian Anderson in the Supreme Court on May 18, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Stacardo Grissett v. State in the Supreme Court on May 16, 2016. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter along with the Record on Appeal in the case of State v. Nelpold Daniels in the Court of Appeals on May 6, 2016. 3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel is striving to limit the number of extensions requested. Counsel is attempting to complete the cases with the most number of extensions first.

4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty-day extension, until April 18, 2016**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and
