**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This matter comes before the Court by way of an Application for Post-Conviction Relief filed in Lexington County on August 17, 2007 (2007-CP-32-2906). The Honorable Roger Young transferred venue to Aiken County in an order dated May 22, 2009. Upon transfer to Aiken County, the current case number was assigned.
