ORDER

Petitioner seeks a writ of certiorari to review the dismissal of his appeal by the court of appeals and has filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. We deny the motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995) (motions to proceed *in forma pauperis* may only be granted where specifically authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions).

Petitioner shall, within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order, pay the \$100 filing fee required by Rule 242(c), SCACR. If the filing fee is not received by this Court within fifteen (15) days of the date of this order, the petition for a writ of certiorari to the court of appeals will be dismissed.
